# Keryn's Corner

# STRAWBERRY & CHICKEN SALAD with STRAWBERRY DRESSING

Prep time: 10 mins Cook: 15 mins Serves: 4

#### Ingredients:

Olive oil-1 Tbsp

Chicken Breast-400 g

Strawberries, tops removed-250g

Baby cos lettuce, roughly shredded-1

Mint leaves-1/4 cup

Garlic, sliced thinly-2 cloves

Cajun seasoning-2 tsp

White wine vinegar-1 Tbsp

Avocado, sliced-1

Walnuts, toasted-1/2 cup

#### Method:

- Heat the oil in a large frying pan to medium heat. Add the sliced garlic, cooking for 2-3 minutes until golden. Spoon the garlic out of the pan and set aside.
- Season the chicken breast with the Cajun and add to the pan, cooking for 7
  minutes each side or until cooked through. Remove from the pan and let it
  rest before cutting into slices.
- For the dressing, blitz or mash 5 strawberries with the vinegar. Cut the remaining strawberries into quarters.
- To assemble the salad, into a large bowl, place the separated cos leaves, chicken, fried garlic, avocado, and strawberries. Sprinkle over the mint leaves and toasted walnuts, and drizzle the dressing before tossing well.
